

The mission of the Border Patrol Foundation (BPF) is to honor the memory of fallen U.S. Border Patrol agents and provide support and resources to the families. BPF provides support to those employed by the Border Patrol for on-and-off duty deaths, injuries, illnesses, family medical emergencies, special circumstances and student scholarships.







## Line of Duty Death

When a Border Patrol Agent is killed in the line of duty, BPF makes a donation of \$10,000, usually within 24 hours, to the family of the fallen. These funds are meant to create a financial bridge through the immediate turbulent time following a family's loss.



<u>Our Progress</u>

Since 2009, BPF has donated **over\$1.2 million** to the families of the U.S. Border Patrol through family support and awarded **\$495,000** in scholarships.



# **BPF Scholarship Program**

BPF has committed to providing support to the families of fallen Border Patrol Agents. Graduating seniors of fallen agents currently receive up to \$25,000 in scholarships over a four year period to a college or trade school of their choice. Other scholasrhips are awarded to the children of acitve and retired Border Patrol employees through a competitive application process.

## **Emergency Financial Support**



For Border Patrol Agents and employees experiencing financial hardship as a result of off-duty death, injury, illness, family medical emergencies or special circumstances, the BPF makes donations of up to \$5,000.





#### <u>Think Big</u>

Our goals include growing our current programs, to provide full ride sholarships to the children of the fallen, and establish a broader base from which to carry our mission and vision. The BPF is always looking for ways to increase support, we offer, especially to the families of our fallen heroes.



#### Where does your donation go?

The BPF maintains administrative costs lower than 12% in-keeping with the not-forprofit industry best practices. The BPF employs one (1) full-time employee and contracts as needed and relies heavily on volunteers to further our mission and support the cause, making sure every dollar counts, That means over 88% of your support goes directly to providing support to the families of the Border Patrol.
